Bill Stovall Scholarship: Following discussion Mike will tweak the application language and send out the revised application to the board and to Bill. The scholarship applications will be reviewed (and an awardee chosen) by a committee of former ESD educators and Bill.

Updated brochure: Change language to "over \$100,000 awarded to date." Mary will order 500.

2023 Event recap:

Pros: Layout (block leg of screen), video, games (make cornhole single elimination, find smaller/softer balls for the football toss). Game ticket prices good (\$1 each, sold in bundles). Cons: Service slow, catered appetizers missed, disposable plates and cutlery affects experience.

Mary noted the price of all incidentals are increasing. With Pasta Co. (including their discount) per meal price is \$28-\$30 per person, plus tax and gratuity. 110 paid attendees + 40 volunteers = 150 meals.

- o Put sponsor logos on wall behind cashiers and/or floor decals for wine walk
- Designate with balloons on tables and nametags
- Include drink tickets in envelope
